New York City man convicted of 2010 Suffolk murder

A 34 year old Brooklyn man was found guilty today of second degree murder for the shooting death of a West Babylon man, Suffolk County District Attorney Thomas Spota said.

The jury took approximately two hours to convict Marcus Lewis, of Flushing Avenue, of shooting 30 year old Michael Anderson in the head in a confrontation n outside the Stone Hedge Pub in West Babylon on September 25, 2010.

Suffolk County Police homicide detectives arrested Lewis in January of last year.

The trial, before Judge John Toomey, began on October 3.

Lewis faces a prison term of 25 years to life when he is sentenced November 9 in Riverhead.
