MILITARY ACTIVE DUTY COMMITMENTS

Any candidate unable to complete all components of the testing process due to active military service should refer to Section 243 of Military Law for information or contact Keith Murphy (information on the next page)

REQUIREMENTS FOR MILITARY MAKE UP-EXAMS

An individual who, due to **active** military duty in the United States Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, Coast Guard or is on **active** duty in any of their respective reserve components, on June 9, 2007, may be eligible for a Military Makeup Exam at a later date.

- The Military Makeup Exam must be completed while still on **active** duty or within six months of being released from **active** duty.

On or before the day of the Military Makeup Exam, a candidate will be required to:

- Submit a copy of a DD-214 or military orders to substantiate the fact that he/she was on active duty on June 9, 2007.
- Certify that he/she has no prior knowledge of the contents of the examination.

VETERANS POINTS

To receive veterans credit one must have served full-time Active Duty in the armed forces of the United States, other than for training.

- NON-DISABLED VETERANS: 5 points for Open-Competitive Exams
- DISABLED VETERANS 10 points for Open-Competitive Exams

These additional credits, which are combined with the final score obtained in the examination, may be granted only to PASSING CANDIDATES at the time of establishment of the eligible list.

AGE REQUIREMENT AND AGE CREDIT

On the date of the exam, one must be between the ages of 19 and 34 years old to take the exam. Applicants that turn 35 on the date of the written exam will be permitted to take the exam.

(Applicants with active military duty, as defined in Section 243 (10-a) of the New York State Military Law, may deduct up to six years from their age to meet the maximum age requirement).
