Campers Should Dispose of Trash in the Dumpsters in Parking Lot  
Trash Should Never Be left Outside on the Beach

### **Generator Hours**

9 am to 1 pm and 5 pm to 9 pm

Excessively loud generators may be asked to be shut off.

### **Quiet Hours**

10:00 PM to 8:00 AM

No visitors during Quiet Hours

## **Campground Speed Limit is 10 MPH**

Air Down All Tires on Truck & Trailer

Fires must be in an Approved Fire Container

Pets must be leashed at all times.

Two vehicles with valid car passes per campsite.

All Vehicles on Beach must have Outer Beach Permit

Use Dump Station for all Waste Disposal

Stay off of the Dunes



## Basic Campground Rules:

1. All campers and guests must follow park rules and park personnel direction.
2. **Check-Out is 12PM** and is strictly enforced.
  - Check out means camper has left the site and no property or excessive garbage remains on the site.
  - Campers are responsible for cleaning their site and removing all trash, litter, property, etc. before checking out. Failure to do so is considered failure to check-out on time.
3. **Scheduled Garbage Pick-ups are 8:30 AM and 2:30 PM**
  - Do not leave garbage out overnight. Any garbage put out at different times may be subject to a littering ticket.
  - Garbage pickup times may vary based on campground activity.
4. **Generators** may run from **9 am to 1 pm** and from **5 pm to 9 pm**
  - Excessively loud generators may be asked to be shut off.
5. **Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 8 am.**
  - All visitors must leave the campground and parking lot by 10 pm.
6. Do not setup campsite or trailer beyond your assigned campsite.
7. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in county parks.
8. All vehicle and traffic laws apply in the park.
  - **Speed Limit is 10 MPH in the campground**
9. Two vehicles with valid car passes are permitted per campsite.
  - Boat trailers count as a vehicle.
  - Additional vehicles may park in the parking lot with the purchase of an additional car parking pass. (based on availability)
10. Two pets permitted on each site.
  - Pets must be leashed and under owners control at all times.
  - Do not leave pets unattended on a site for any reason.
11. Swimming is not permitted.
12. Closed Bottom Fire ring required for all fires.
  - Campers must dispose of fire ash.

# Enjoy Your Stay!

## TIPS AND PRACTICES

1. Wherever possible, use existing tracks. Driving all over the beach is reckless and can be harmful to your vehicle and beach.
2. Use designated access roads only. Undesignated area access is illegal, and can cause erosion leaving the beach vulnerable to storm damage.
3. Ruts and holes caused by a stuck vehicle must be filled in after said vehicle has been removed.
4. Tire pressure should be at least one half the maximum recommended pressure located on the side-wall of the tire. (A pressure of 16 to 20 pounds is a safe range)
5. Be aware of Children at Play.

## WHAT IF I GET STUCK?

1. Do not spin your tires
2. Check and make sure you are in 4 wheel drive.
3. Lower tire pressure between 15 and 18 psi.
4. Pull a small amount of sand away from the front and rear of all four tires.
5. Slowly attempt to drive in reverse, where the sand is compacted.
6. Keep front tires straight, back up and attempt to free your vehicle.
7. Proceed evenly, keeping up your momentum without spinning your tires.
8. If buried, jack vehicle up first, then compact sand under tires.
