At its November 20, 2019 meeting, the CEQ reviewed the above referenced matter. Pursuant to Article I of the Suffolk County Charter, and based on the information received, as well as that given in a presentation by Mr. Richard Martin, Director of Historic Services, Suffolk County Department Parks, Recreation and Conservation, and Mary Cascone, Director of Town of Babylon Historic Services, the Council recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, in CEQ Resolution No. 48-2019, that the County dedicate the 1927 "World War Veterans Club" and Property Located at 185 North Broadway, Lindenhurst to the Suffolk County Historic Trust pursuant to section C1-8 of the Suffolk County Charter.

**HISTORIC TRUST RECOMMENDATION CONCERNING
DEDICATION OF THE 1927 "WORLD WAR VETERANS CLUB"
AND PROPERTY LOCATED AT 185 NORTH BROADWAY,
LINDENHURST TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY HISTORIC TRUST**

WHEREAS, Article I, Environmental Bill of Rights of the Suffolk County Charter section C1-8 establishes the Suffolk County Historic Trust; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Bill of Rights section C-1-4 states that a function of the Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is to make recommendations to the County Legislature and County Executive as to what county-owned properties should be dedicated to the county historic trust; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 871-1972, establishing the Historic Trust designates the voting members of the CEQ as the members of the County Historic Trust; and

WHEREAS, at its November 20, 2019 meeting, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality reviewed the associated information that was submitted by the Historic Services Division of the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation; and

WHEREAS, a presentation on the proposed dedication was also given at the meeting by Richard Martin, Director of Historic Services, Suffolk County Department Parks, Recreation and Conservation, and Mary Cascone, Director of Town of Babylon Historic Services; and

WHEREAS, the presentation noted that Suffolk County originally purchased the 1927 "World War Veterans Club" building and property located at 185 North Broadway, Lindenhurst (Suffolk County Tax Map Number 0103-010.00-01.00-038.000) in 1999 and then sold the property to the Town of Babylon in 2000 for the purpose of using the property as a cultural arts center, with the intention of developing a veteran's museum; and

WHEREAS, the property has remained unused and unimproved by the Town of Babylon for the past 20 years, in violation of the reverter clause in the deed, and the Town has recently agreed to transfer the subject property back to Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Suffolk County Resolution 1840-2019, which was adopted by Suffolk County on October 9, 2019, the Suffolk County Real Estate Division is directed to transfer the property from the Town of Babylon back to Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, the presentation also noted that the "World War Veterans Club" which occupied the building was an active participant not only in the service during World War I but also in the community as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the CEQ Historic Trust Committee has recommended to the CEQ that the 1927 "World War Veterans Club" building and property located at 185 North Broadway, Lindenhurst be dedicated to the Suffolk County Historic Trust due to both the properties historic architectural and contextual setting; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the CEQ, as members of the Suffolk County Historic Trust, recommend to the County Legislature and County Executive, that upon Suffolk County retaking ownership of the 1927 "World War Veterans Club" building and property at 185 North Broadway, Lindenhurst (Suffolk County Tax Map Number 0103-010.00-01.00-038.000), that said property should be dedicated to the Suffolk County Historic Trust pursuant to section C1-8 of the Suffolk County Charter; and, be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the 1927 "World War Veterans Club" and property Historic Trust dedication be assigned the following use and preservation categories as set forth in the Historic Trust Manual as adopted by the Council on Environmental Quality as members of the Historic Trust:

Use Categories:

(M) - Museum

(F) - Functional

Preservation Categories:

(A) – Architectural

(C) – Context and Setting

and, be it further

3rd RESOLVED, the proposed activity constitutes a Type II Action under the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(c)(26)(33), since it involves a local legislative decision for the routine or continuing agency administration and that the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive adopt a SEQRA determination to that effect.

CEQ RESOLUTION NO. 49-2019, RECOMMENDATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF SEQRA AND CHAPTER 450 OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE CONCERNING THE REVIEW OF THE DGEIS COMMENTS AND THE PREPARATION OF A FINAL GENERIC ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT ON THE SUFFOLK COUNTY SUBWATERSHEDS WASTEWATER PLAN

WHEREAS, Suffolk County, as SEQRA Lead Agency, adopted Resolution No. 849-2016 issuing a Positive Declaration and requiring the preparation of a Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement (DGEIS) for the Suffolk County Subwatersheds Wastewater Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, on November 29, 2016 and December 1, 2016 Suffolk County held public scoping hearings to solicit comments and identify issues to be addressed regarding the preparation of the DGEIS; and

WHEREAS, at its February 15, 2017 meeting, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) reviewed the draft scoping document for the DGEIS and found that it adequately addressed all substantive comments and recommended to the County Executive and Legislature that a resolution be prepared adopting the document; and

WHEREAS, Suffolk County Resolution No. 176-2017 adopted the final scoping document outlining the preparation of the DGEIS; and

WHEREAS, in July 2019, the CEQ received the initial draft of the DGEIS from the Suffolk County Department of Health Services; and

WHEREAS, at its August 14, 2019 meeting, pursuant to Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality reviewed the updated DGEIS and found the DGEIS to be satisfactory with respect to its scope, content and adequacy subject to the additional agreed upon amendments noted at the August 14, 2019 CEQ meeting and should be released for public review and comment; and

WHEREAS, the public comment period on the DGEIS included two public hearings (one in Riverhead on September 5, 2019 and one in Brentwood on September 6, 2019); and

WHEREAS, based upon input received during initial public comment period and in an effort to receive all comments and concerns from the public, the Suffolk County Department of Health Services requested that the CEQ extend the written comment period on the DGEIS for an additional 30 days; and

WHEREAS, at its September 18, 2019 meeting, pursuant to Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality reviewed the Suffolk County Department of Health Service's request for a 30 day extension of the public written comment period for the Subwatersheds Wastewater Management Plan and authorized said 30 day extension until October 16, 2019; and

WHEREAS, at the November 20, 2019 meeting, the CEQ reviewed the transcript of the public hearings and all of the written comments received on the DGEIS as well as a presentation

provided by Ken Zegel, Principal Public Health Engineer and Anthony Caniano, Associate Hydrogeologist with the Suffolk County Department of Health Services; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that in the judgment of the CEQ, based on its review of the written and oral comments presented and received, a quorum of the Council at their November 20, 2019 meeting recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, pursuant to Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, that the majority of the comments received are substantive and a Final Generic Environmental Impact Statement should be prepared on the Suffolk County Subwatersheds Wastewater Plan.
