RE: Proposed Suffolk County Introductory Resolution 1413-2020 (IR -1413-2020) – A Charter Law Increasing the Percentage of Sales Tax that is Allocated to the Suffolk County Taxpayers Trust Fund and Decreasing the Percentage of Sales Tax that is Allocated to the Suffolk County Environmental Programs Trust Fund for Three Years

At its June 17, 2020 meeting, the CEQ reviewed the above referenced matter. Pursuant to Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, and based on the information received, and the information provided at the meeting by, Eric Naughton, Budget Director, Suffolk County Office of Management and Budget, the Council advises the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive in CEQ Resolution No. 46-2020, a copy of which is attached, that the proposed project be considered an Unlisted Action under SEQRA that will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment.

If the Legislature concurs with the Council on Environmental Quality's recommendation that the project will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment, the Presiding Officer should cause to be brought before the Legislature for a vote, a resolution determining that the proposed action is an Unlisted Action pursuant to SEQRA that will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment (negative declaration). However, if the Legislature has further environmental concerns regarding this project and needs additional information, the Presiding Officer should remand the case back to the initiating unit for the necessary changes to the project and EAF or submit a resolution authorizing the initiating unit to prepare a draft environmental impact statement (positive declaration).

Please also note, that while not part of its formal SEQRA recommendation, the CEQ recommended that the voter Proposition language contained in the resolution be clarified to provide the public with a more complete understanding of the Proposition. The CEQ recommends that the referendum be improved in two ways. First, the referendum wording should clarify the program elements involved. For example, we suggest adding “**...ALLOCATED TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL PROGRAMS TRUST FUND FOR OPEN SPACE AND FARMLAND PRESERVATION PURCHASES FOR THREE YEARS...**” The second improvement we recommend to the referendum language is to describe how capital budgeting will be used to offset the sales tax percentage decrease to ensure no net reduction in the proportion of funds available for Environmental Programs Trust Fund.

CEQ RESOLUTION NO. 46-2020, RECOMMENDATION CONCERNING A SEQRA CLASSIFICATION AND DETERMINATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF CHAPTER 450 OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE FOR THE PROPOSED SUFFOLK COUNTY INTRODUCTORY RESOLUTION 1413-2020 (IR-1413-2020) – A CHARTER LAW INCREASING THE PERCENTAGE OF SALES TAX THAT IS ALLOCATED TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY TAXPAYERS TRUST FUND AND DECREASING THE PERCENTAGE OF SALES TAX THAT IS ALLOCATED TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL PROGRAMS TRUST FUND FOR THREE YEARS

WHEREAS, at its June 17, 2020 meeting, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) reviewed the EAF for the above referenced action and associated information submitted by the Suffolk County Office of Management and Budget; and

WHEREAS, a presentation regarding the project was also given at the meeting by Eric Naughton, Budget Director with the Suffolk County Office of Management and Budget; and

WHEREAS, the proposed action (the adoption of Suffolk County Introductory Resolution 1413-2020 followed by voter referendum approval) would result in the temporary reduction (31% percent to 20% in calendar year 2020; 31% to 24% in calendar year 2021; and 31% to 20% in calendar year 2022) of money designated for the acquisition of open space/parkland and farmland development rights in the Suffolk County Drinking Water Protection Program to allow for an increased percentage of money designated for County wide property tax protection (32% percent to 43 % in calendar year 2020; 32% to 39% in calendar year 2021; and 32% to 43% in calendar year 2022); and

WHEREAS, the proposed action also includes a provision that if the Capital Budgets in 2021, 2022 and 2023, does not include funding for purchases of farmland development rights, open space, wetlands, woodlands, pine barrens, and other lands which are suitable only for passive, recreational use, land for use as hamlet greens, hamlet parks, pocket parks (with the effect of providing public spaces that reinforce community livability by enhancing the pedestrian-friendly nature of communities, including uses for outdoor activities, playgrounds, and other public gathering purposes), active parkland, active recreation, historic and/or cultural park uses permitted pursuant to §C12-2(A)(2)(a) of the Suffolk County Charter, equal to the amount of funds reduced the preceding year in the environmental protection component of the Drinking Water Protection Program a transfer must be made back to Suffolk County Environmental Programs Trust Fund of the Suffolk County Drinking Water Protection Program; and

WHEREAS, the proposed action also includes a provision that if serial bonds are not authorized by the Suffolk County Legislature in the amounts contained in Capital Budgets for 2021, 2022 or 2023 in either 2021, 2022 or 2023 for purchases set forth above, a transfer shall be made by December 31st of the applicable year from the Suffolk County Taxpayers Trust Fund to the Suffolk County Environmental Programs Trust Fund in an amount equal to the difference between the amount that would otherwise have been allocated and dedicated to the Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed local law cannot take effect unless approved by voter referendum; now therefore, be it

1st RESOLVED, that based on the information received and presented, a quorum of the CEQ hereby recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive that the proposed activity be classified as an Unlisted Action under the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code; and, be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that based on the information received, a quorum of the CEQ recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, that the proposed project will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment for the following reasons:

1. The proposed action will not exceed any of the criteria in 6 NYCRR, Section 617.7, which sets forth thresholds for determining significant effect on the environment as demonstrated in the Environmental Assessment Form;
2. The proposal does not significantly threaten any unique or highly valuable environmental or cultural resources as identified in or regulated by the Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York or the Suffolk County Charter and Code;
3. The proposed action will result in budgetary changes to the Suffolk County Drinking Water Protection Program but these budgetary changes do not have the potential to have a significant adverse impact on the environment;
4. The proposed action will not impact the existing environmental regulations and requirements that are in place to protect Suffolk County's environmental resources;
5. The possible debt services involved with this proposed action will be satisfied with the Suffolk County General Fund Capital budget and not with the Suffolk County Drinking Water Protection Program;
6. Allocation and dedication of funding involved with this proposed action will be made within a reasonable time period within the applicable calendar year;

and, be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that it is the recommendation of the Council that the Legislature and County Executive adopt a SEQRA determination of non-significance (negative declaration).

CEQ RESOLUTION NO. 47-2020, RECOMMENDATION CONCERNING A SEQRA CLASSIFICATION AND DETERMINATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF CHAPTER 450 OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE FOR THE PROPOSED SUFFOLK COUNTY INTRODUCTORY RESOLUTION 1414-2020 (IR-1414-2020) – A CHARTER LAW TO TRANSFER EXCESS FUNDS IN THE SEWER ASSESSMENT STABILIZATION RESERVE FUND TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY TAXPAYERS TRUST FUND AND TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT THAT INTERFUND TRANSFERS BE MADE FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE SEWER ASSESSMENT STABILIZATION FUND

WHEREAS, at its June 17, 2020 meeting, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) reviewed the EAF for the above referenced proposed action and associated information submitted by the Suffolk County Office of Management and Budget; and

WHEREAS, a presentation regarding the proposed action was also given at the meeting by Eric Naughton, Budget Director with the Suffolk County Office of Management and Budget and John Corral, Environmental Projects Coordinator and Staff to the CEQ; and

WHEREAS, the proposed action (the adoption of Suffolk County Introductory Resolution 1414-2020 followed by voter referendum approval) would result in the reduction in the amount of excess funds in the Sewer Assessment Stabilization Reserve (ASRF) to allow for an increase in funds designated for County-wide property tax protection; and

WHEREAS, the ASRF falls under the sewer taxpayer protection component of the Suffolk County Drinking Water Protection Program; and

WHEREAS, if revenues deposited into the ASRF exceed the required payments for sewer district tax stabilization, the surplus results in excess funds in the ASRF; and

WHEREAS, the excess funds in the ASRF are required to be spent pursuant to Section C-12.2.D of the Suffolk County Drinking Water Protection Program; and

WHEREAS, as indicated in the EAF's analysis, based on the requirements of how the excess funds in the ASRF are required to be spent, the reduction of excess funds in the ASRF that will result from the proposed action will not necessitate a reduction in funds spent on sewer infrastructure spending but will result in a reduction in the amount of excess funds being carried over annually as fund balance in the excess ASRF fund; and

WHEREAS, this proposed local law cannot take effect unless approved by voter referendum; now therefore, be it

1st RESOLVED, that based on the information received and presented, a quorum of the CEQ hereby recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive that the proposed activity be classified as an Unlisted Action under the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code; and, be it further

DAVIS PARK, CP 5385, TOWN OF BROOKHAVEN**

WHEREAS, at its June 17, 2020 meeting, a presentation regarding the proposed construction of a dune crossover at Davis Park, CP 5385, Town of Brookhaven, was given at the meeting by Robert Whelan, Principal Civil Engineer, Suffolk County Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project involves construction of a new public crossover to traverse a newly constructed dune to allow access to the ocean beach from Donella Walk in Davis Park; and

WHEREAS, the newly constructed dune was the result of the Fire Island Inlet to Moriches Inlet Stabilization Project (FIMI) project which was done to provide protection to the Long Island mainland and Fire Island by reducing the potential for barrier island breaching and overwash during significant storm events; and

WHEREAS, during the FIMI project, Donella Walk was the only walk in Davis Park that was not slated for a crossover because it did not extend to the beach due to private property issues, however during the FIMI Real Estate acquisition process a parcel that hindered the construction of the walk was acquired by the County making the construction of the walk possible; and

WHEREAS, the proposed crossover at Donella Walk will protect the dune from unauthorized pedestrian crossing; and

WHEREAS, the proposed crossover structure design was patterned after the typical design used by the United States Army Core of Engineers for crossover walks in the FIMI project; now, therefore, be it

1st RESOLVED, that based on the information received and presented, a quorum of the CEQ hereby recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive that the proposed activity be classified as an Unlisted Action under the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code; and, be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that based on the information received, a quorum of the CEQ recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, that the proposed project will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment for the following reasons:

1. The proposed action will not exceed any of the criteria of 6 NYCRR, Section 617.7, which sets forth thresholds for determining significant effect on the environment, as demonstrated in the Environmental Assessment Form;
