Brief Description of Proposed Action (include purpose, intent and the environmental resources that may be affected): Preventing the spread and eliminating the invasive Phragmites in the Stony Brook Creek is the proposed action. Phragmites is an aggressive invasive wetland grass that kills native plants and displaces native animals. Because of its height and its seedheads, the Phragmites in Stony Brook Creek have rapidly grown. The project will benefit the environments health in ways such as increasing water flow drainage in the channel, restoring both plant and animal biodiversity. Early detection and rapid reponse is key to restoring and protecting the wetlands. The plan of action for the Phragmites removal project begins with removing the Phragmites populations with a hand cutting method in the late summer and to then to conduct a follow up cutting in the fall to ensure maximum efficiency. This plan of action and prevention method is the safest and most sustainable approach to removing Phragmites in order to ensure that the wetlands is not disrupted during the removal.




