III. TABLED PERMIT APPLICATIONS

A. <u>BRANDYWINE TRUST COMPANY, TRUSTEE FOR THE FONSECA 2010 FAMILY</u> <u>TRUST AND THE FONSECA QTIP TRUST</u>

(f/k/a TRUSTEE FOR THE RICHARD CORNUELLE 2010 MARITAL TRUST) 149 Long Lane, East Hampton North, Town of East Hampton

Tax Map #: 0300-157.00-03.00-011.004 (28.7 ± acres)

The applicant seeks a Special Use Permit for the installation and maintenance of a drainage structure, in association with a commercial agricultural operation. The land has been excavated and soil has been removed from the premises prior to submission of this application. (Application No. 2012025)

Bob Braun stated that the County is still in the middle of discovery and there still is ongoing discussion between the Town of East Hampton and the owner about the depth of soil to be restored to the property.

IV. PROPOSED FARMLAND PDR ACQUISITION PARCELS

A. BAITING HOLLOW MEADOW, LLC

2477 Sound Avenue, Calverton, Town of Riverhead Tax Map #: 0600-062.00-04.00-002.000 p/o (91.5 \pm of 98.2 \pm acres) The applicant requests that the above referenced parcel be considered for inclusion in the Suffolk County Farmland Purchase of Development Rights Program. (Application No. (NFP-2017-01)

Lauretta Fischer presented the proposed acquisition.

The location of the applicant's proposed 6.7-acre cut out was reconsidered and relocated to the northeast portion of the property, as recommended by Jeff Rottkamp.

Access to the proposed 6.7-acre cut out would be provided from Sound Avenue by an approximate 28.4 foot wide accessway to run south along the eastern side of the flag strip of SCRPTM number 0600-062.00-04.00-002.000.

Access to the proposed 91.5-acre PDR area would be provided from Sound Avenue by an

approximate 28.4 foot wide accessway to run south along the western side of the flag strip of SCRPTM number 0600-062.00-04.00-002.000.

A motion was put forth by Jeff Rottkamp, and seconded by Nate Corwin, to recommend SCRPTM # 0600-062.00-04.00-002.000 p/o, as amended, consisting of 91.5 acres out of 98.2 acres in size, for consideration by the Suffolk County Legislature for inclusion in the Suffolk County Farmland Purchase of Development Rights Program, as outlined in Committee Resolution FC-3-2017. Motion Carried: 14-0-0 [See Exhibit "C" for Committee Resolution FC-3-2017].

V. VIOLATIONS

B. VERNON F. WELLS, JR. ET AL.

Sound Avenue, Northville, Town of Riverhead Tax Map #: 0600-020.00-03.00-003.000, 007.002, 008.002 and 0600-045.00-02.00-002.003 (116.3 ± acres)

Lauretta Fischer informed the Committee that the County received a copy of a New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYS DEC) Notice of Violation letter, dated November 21, 2016, that was issued to the landowners of nine parcels located in Northville, in the Town of Riverhead. The Notice states that inspections by NYS DEC indicate that the landowners are in violation of Article 27 of NYS Environmental Conservation and its implementing Codes, Rules and Regulations.

The County is specifically concerned with four County PDR parcels which are owned by Vernon F. Wells, Jr. and others. NYS DEC documented violations of receiving and stockpiling solid waste materials consisting of construction and demolition debris that had been received for onsite road grading and had already been spread in some areas.

On January 24, 2017, the County conducted a site inspection of the four County PDR parcels and observed materials on them consistent with NYS DEC's observations.

On January 25, 2017, NYS DEC indicated that a case referral had been prepared for their legal office to review and possibly prepare a Consent Order. The County will continue to work with NYS DEC and will keep the Committee informed as further information is received from DEC.

VI. OTHER BUSINESS

A. <u>DISCUSSION</u>

POTATO ACRES, LLC

Church Lane, Town of Riverhead Tax Map # 0600-021.00-02.00-018.002 Proposed Town Stormwater drainage easement – preliminary conversation

Lauretta Fischer discussed a preliminary request from the Town of Riverhead for the installation of a proposed stormwater system on County PDR land known as "Potato Acres" to address drainage issues. The proposed stormwater system along the western boundary of the property would include a 143-foot long pipe, two 2-foot high berms and

a 2-foot high swale. The two berms and swale would individually be 8 feet wide by 40 feet long. The Town is proposing to enter into a drainage easement with the landowner to install and maintain a drainage system in perpetuity at the Town's expense.

According to Chapter 8, prior to the recent court decision, the County would have requested a permit for these improvements. (Berms are considered structures and would have required an Agricultural Development Permit and drainage systems are utilities which would have required a Special Use Permit.) There is a question as to whether the Farmland Committee can move forward with an application regarding these improvements at this time. A second question is whether this type of easement would be allowed on a County PDR property where the County has obtained the deed of development rights.

Lauretta Fischer scheduled a site inspection for next Tuesday, January 31, 2017, to evaluate the site with Corey Humphrey from the SC Soil and Water Conservation District. Ms. Fischer requested Farmland Committee members to attend, if available. Corey Humphrey provided some preliminary comments regarding the proposed stormwater system.

B. CHAPTER 8 LAWSUIT - UPDATE

County Attorney Dennis Brown provided an update regarding the Chapter 8 lawsuit. He stated that the final judgement has finally been signed and served and that the County's appeal will be proceeding from this final judgement. Introductory Resolution No. 1025-2017 has been laid on table at the Legislature for the proposed adoption of a local law to ensure continuity of farmland preservation and agricultural production on SC PDR farmland.

A motion was put forth by August Ruckdeschel, and seconded by Howard Johnson to move into Executive Session.

Dennis Brown answered questions from the Committee members.
