PUBLIC NOTICE

AMNESTY PROGRAM

FOR LATE FEES AND PENALTIES ON FINES PAST DUE AS OF NOVEMBER 30TH 2018

THROUGH FEBRUARY 28TH

The Suffolk County Traffic and Parking Violations Agency is implementing an Amnesty Program for motorists with open or outstanding late fines and judgments in this Agency as of November 30th, 2018. The program provides an opportunity for motorists to come into compliance with the law and reinstate their drivers' licenses which may have been suspended for failure to pay said fines and fees.

Parking tickets with an existing judgment on said ticket as of November 30th, 2018 will be eligible for amnesty as well. For Red Light Camera citations with an existing judgment but not with a suspended registration or pending suspension hearing, the TPVA will waive late fees of \$25. The program will also apply to moving violations, including those which may have been pled to parking tickets.

Following the amnesty program, offenders' vehicles with outstanding fines will be subject to booting and/or towing. Motorists who wish to participate in the Amnesty Program will be required to handle all open and closed matters with the Agency in person and to speak with a clerk regarding all of their matters.
